MEMORANDUM OF SITE VISIT QUESTIONS:

SUBJECT: DACW17-03-B-0006, SOUTH JETTY SAND TIGHTENING, SOUTH JETTY REHABILITATION, NORTH JETTY REHABILITATION, AND NORTH REVETMENT REHABILITATION, PALM BEACH HARBOR, FLORIDA

QUESTION #1: Is contract award going to be based on base bid or the cumulative sum of all the options?

ANSWER #1: See Notes (1) and (4) of Section 00010A (Line Items and Pricing Schedule).

QUESTION #2a: Is the contractor expected to protect present vegetation along the Kuvin property along south jetty, and if so,

QUESTION #2b: can endangered species be identified by government agencies?

ANSWER #2.a.: Contractor does not need to protect vegetation along the jetty (the jetty and adjacent land is owned by the Federal Government).

ANSWER #2.b.: Any issues with regard to endangered species are covered in the specs (Section 01355, paragraph 3.1.5.).

QUESTION #3: There are survey monuments on top of jetties established by the county. Can contractor proceed to destroy them? Has CORPS taken action to replace/ restore these reference survey markers?
