SUMMARY OF CHANGES

c. This contract is subject to the Robert T. Stafford Emergency Relief and Emergency Assistance Act. In accordance with FAR 26.201(a) "When contracting under this subpart for major disaster or emergency assistance activities, such as debris clearance, distribution of supplies, or reconstruction, preference shall be given, to the extent feasible and practicable, to those organizations, firms, or individuals residing or doing business primarily in the area affected by such major disaster or emergency."

To comply with FAR 26.201(a), the solicitation is amended as follows:

Section 00101B, paragraph EVAL-2 is deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted:

EVAL-2 Determining Best Value. The Government plans to award as many as 20 contracts under this solicitation. The first award will be made to the technically acceptable offeror who submits the lowest price, without regard to the locale where the offeror primarily does business. The first award will set the market price for this work. After the first award is made, the Government will select the next 19 technically acceptable offerors based on (i) locale where the offeror primarily does business and (ii) the offeror's price. These 19 offerors will be afforded an opportunity to revise their prices downward to the market price. No more than 20 contracts will be awarded. If less than 20 contracts are awarded, awards will be made in the following order: First - firms doing business primarily in the declared disaster area with lowest initial prices. Second - after exhausting all eligible firms doing business primarily in the declared disaster area, firms not doing business primarily in the declared disaster area with lowest initial prices. To qualify as a firm doing business primarily in the declared disaster area, the firm must establish that at least 51% of its business within the last year was done in the declared disaster area.
