SUMMARY OF CHANGES

B. Notice is hereby given that Contract No. W912EP-04-D-0031 has been awarded to Campbell Roofing & Construction Inc. at the prices contained in the attached pricing schedule. In accordance with the terms of the solicitation, we are now ready to proceed with the second phase of the source selection. This phase will determine which offerors receive the additional contracts contemplated by the solicitation. As a reminder, here are the rules for the second phase:

(1) Remaining offerors have been ranked in accordance with the price of their initial offer. (For example, the offeror that submitted the lowest price is ranked number one.)

(2) In accordance with the Stafford Act, we will give priority to firms doing business primarily in the disaster area. By this amendment offerors will be asked to represent whether they do business primarily in the declared disaster area. Based on these representations, offerors will be re-ranked in two categories: those doing business primarily in the disaster area and those not doing business primarily in the disaster area. Since we have two disaster declarations (one in Alabama and one in Florida), we will attempt to distribute the contracts equitably between the disaster areas. After all eligible firms doing business primarily in the disaster areas have been accommodated, other firms will be considered.

(3) All offerors will be provided an opportunity to accept a contract at the prices established by Contract No. W912EP-04-D-0031.

(4) Offerors who agree to accept a contract at the established prices will be eligible for award in the order established by rankings discussed in (1) and (2) above. For example, the first contract will go to the highest ranked offeror doing business primarily in the Alabama disaster area and the second contract will go to the highest ranked offeror doing business primarily in the Florida disaster area. This process will be repeated until we have awarded all the contracts we need.

(5) The solicitation originally contemplated award of as many as 10 contracts. Notice is hereby given that we may award more than 10 contracts if deemed necessary.

(6) In order to maintain your ranking as discussed in (1) and (2) above, you must respond by 3:00 PM today, 18 September 2004. Offers received after this time will be considered if the number of timely responses does not satisfy the Government's needs. Late offers will be considered in the order in which they are received.

THE QUANTITIES SHOWN IN THE PRICING SCHEDULE REPRESENT THE GOVERNMENT'S ESTIMATES OF THE TOTAL REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE ENTIRE MISSION, WHICH IS ESTIMATED AT 20,000 HOMES. THE GOVERNMENT WILL PURCHASE A MINIMUM OF \$100,000.00 WORTH OF SERVICES UNDER EACH CONTRACT. THE MAXIMUM AMOUNT TO BE ORDERED UNDER ALL CONTRACTS SHALL NOT EXCEED TOTAL FUNDING MADE AVAILABLE FOR THIS MISSION BY FEMA.
 - (3) THIS CONTRACT IS SUBJECT TO THE ROBERT T. STAFFORD DISASTER RELIEF AND EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE ACT.

(ALSO REQUIRES 350 LF OF CONTRACTOR-FURNISHED FURRING STRIPS.) CLIN 0002 - 11.5 SF. CLIN 0003 - 1 LF. THIS IS NOT A GUARANTEE THAT A TYPICAL ROOF REPAIR FOR IVAN WILL BE THE SAME AS A TYPICAL ROOF REPAIR FOR CHARLEY.
 - (5) AFTER A REASONABLE RAMP-UP PERIOD, EACH CONTRACTOR SHOULD BE PREPARED TO REPAIR AT LEAST 100 ROOFS PER DAY.
 - (6) TASK ORDERS MAY BE PLACED BY ANY CORPS OF ENGINEERS CONTRACTING OFFICER ASSIGNED TO HURRICANE IVAN RESPONSE AND RECOVER OPERATIONS.
